

# Crossing Treatment Guide

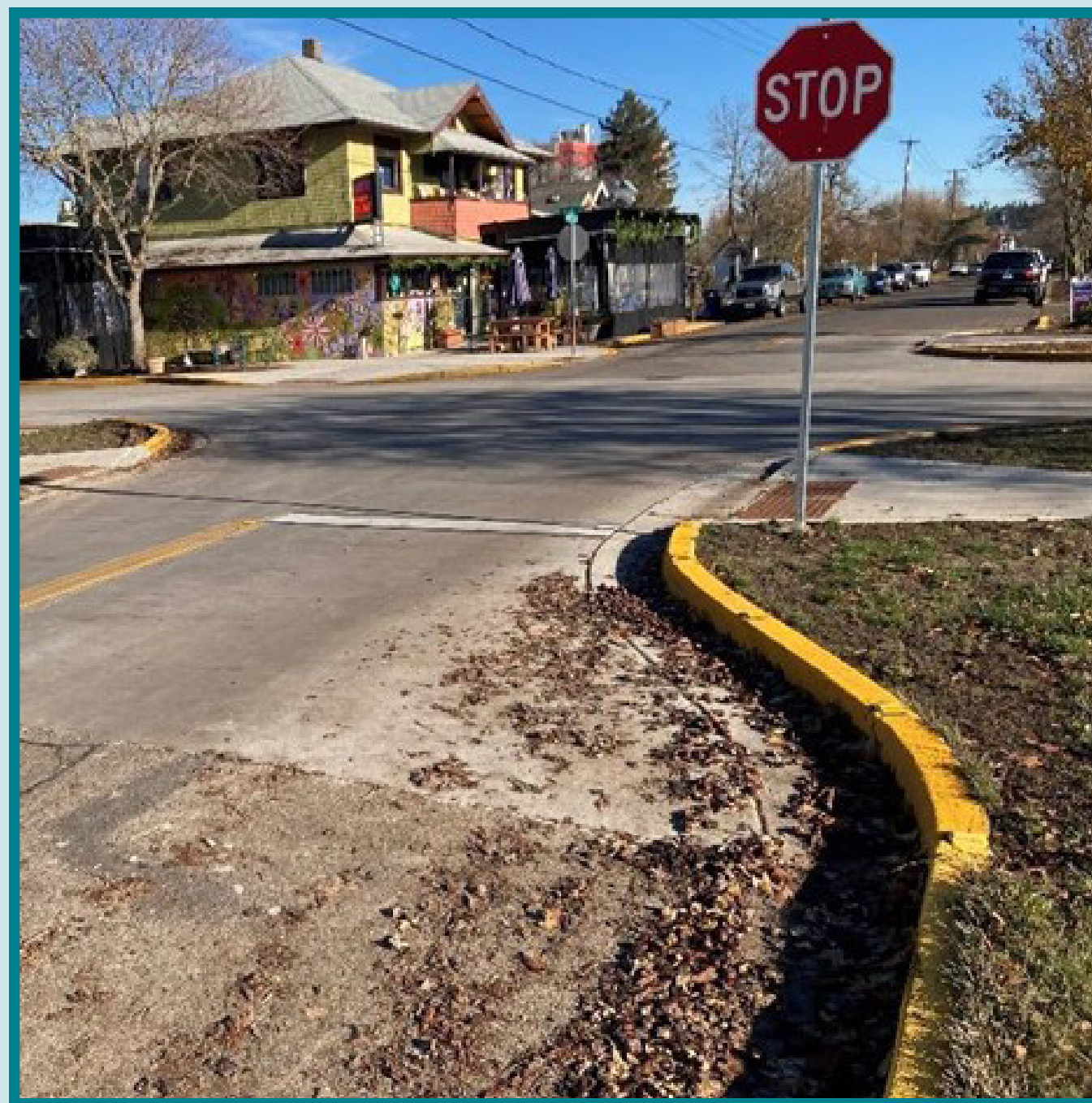
## Seven Crossing Treatments from Around Eugene

We assessed curb cuts for the presence of these seven crossing treatments



### ***Raised Crosswalks***

Raised crosswalks elevate the crossing space to slow drivers and improve pedestrian visibility



### ***Curb Bump Outs***

Bump Outs protrude into the road to increase pedestrian visibility and slow down vehicles



### ***Parking Restrictions***

Parking Restrictions reduce the amount of visual "clutter" that may interrupt line of sight between pedestrians waiting to cross, and oncoming traffic



### ***Signage***

Signage can be used in many different forms and locations to alert drivers of street crossings



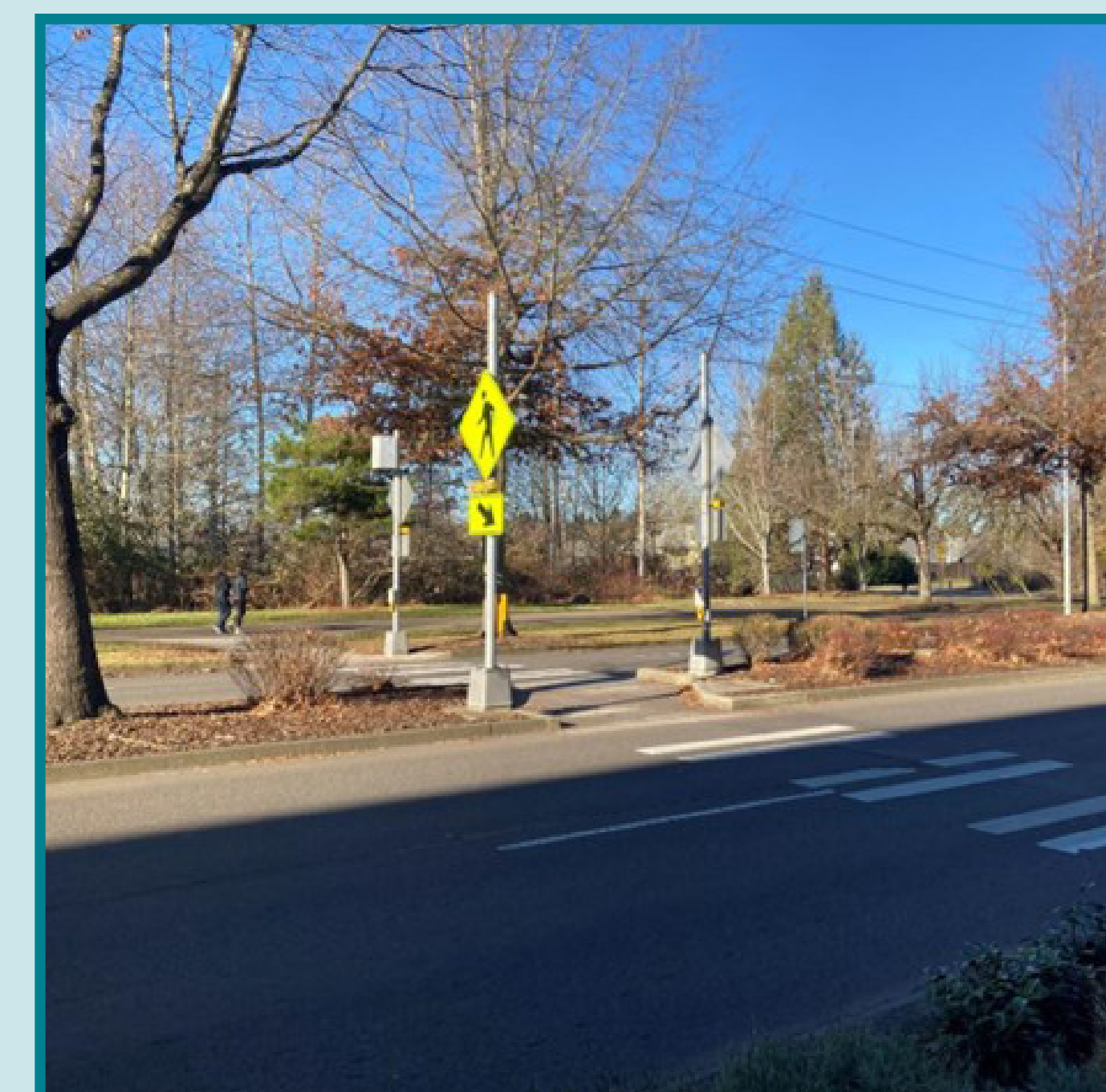
### ***Pedestrian Refuge Islands***

Pedestrian Refuge Islands allow pedestrians to wait safely midway across a fast-moving intersection



### ***Pedestrian Crossing Signals***

Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons combine lighting and signage to get drivers' attention in high traffic, low visibility locations



### ***Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons***

Pedestrian Crossing Signals are lights that specifically indicate to pedestrians the appropriate time to cross
