3. Planters & Curb Extensions

- Decreases crossing distances
- Reduces turning radius and car speeds
- Provides more shared public space: more room on sidewalks allows more room for public amenities benches, drinking fountains, bike parking, or trees and rain gardens



4. Painted Crosswalks

- Indicates to pedestrians that they are prioritized
- Gives cars a visual cue to stop before the intersection
- Can be customized as a painted mural that adds to neighborhood identity & place-making
